MONDAY, 14 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Arrive Adelaide (Dinner)

Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.

On arrival into Adelaide you will check into your hotel where you will spend the following 3 nights. This evening you will enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel where you will meet your fellow travellers.

TUESDAY, 15 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Ultimate Adelaide and Hahndorf (Breakfast)

Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.

The coastal city of Adelaide is noted for its many festivals, its food, wine and culture, and its long beach fronts. On your city tour this morning you will discover superb architecture, cultural boulevards, surrounding park lands and wide streets and then you'll appreciate why we have been ranked as one of the most liveable cities in the world. You will visit Adelaide's Cultural Boulevard of North Terrace, driving by the University, Library, Art Gallery and Museum. You will also visit Historic North Adelaide and the National Wine Centre of Australia. Following the tour you will stop for lunch (at own expense) before continuing into the Adelaide Hills this afternoon as you make your way to the historic German settlement of Hahndorf. The Adelaide Hills is home to the Mt Lofty Ranges, rolling vineyards, unspoiled bush land and rich farmland. You will drive past Bridgewater Mill water wheel and the villages of Crafers Stirling and Aldgate. You will stop at the Beerenberg Farm Shop for some tastings before continuing to Hahndorf. On arrival you will have some free time to wander along the main street of Australia's oldest surviving German settlement. You can visit the iconic pubs, taste some delicious food, and rummage through the souvenir stores including art, craft, leather and fabric, or visit one of the many galleries. You will then transfer back to the city arriving at your hotel early this evening.

WEDNESDAY, 16 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Barossa Food and Wine Experience (Breakfast, Lunch)

Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.

Wine, lunch, history and local produce are the delights of today's tour in the internationally acclaimed Barossa Valley. Your first stop will be at Pindarie Wines, a family owned and award winning cellar door. A family winemaker will share the story of this stunning property and will lead you through tastings in the all-charm sandstone stables converted into a cellar door. Then, it's coffee and cake on the verandah before continuing to your next stop at the main street of Tanunda, where you will have some free time to explore the charming boutiques, galleries and local shops. A photo stop will then be made at Mengler Hill Lookout, with fabulous sweeping views across the Valley, before continuing to your lunch stop at the beautiful Lambert Estate. With panoramic vineyard views, halls of local art, and a sun-drenched balcony, you will be treated to wine tastings along with family anecdotes and wine notes. Following lunch here, your tour continues to Chateau Tanunda, which celebrates over 130 years of winemaking history, and is viewed by many as the birthplace of the Barossa wine industry. Home to some of the oldest Shiraz wines in the world, you will be taken on a guided walk around this magnificent property, while enjoying a taste of their wine. From here it's on to Maggie Beer's Farm Shop, where you will have time to browse the collection for souvenirs to take home, or perhaps enjoy an afternoon treat with a tea/coffee (own cost). Your tour concludes with a drive along Seppeltsfield Road, one of the Barossa's most iconic landscapes. As you wind down this historic palm-lined road, you'll pass through a tapestry of lush vineyards, rolling hills, and heritage sights before continuing back to Adelaide arriving at your hotel early this evening.

THURSDAY, 17 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Depart Adelaide on The Indian Pacific (Breakfast, Dinner)

Overnight: Indian Pacific - Gold Class.

After checking out of your hotel this morning, you will have free time to explore the city on your own. This afternoon you will transfer to the Adelaide train station to board the Indian Pacific for your two night journey to Perth. This evening you will celebrate the start of your journey with the 'Flavours of South Australia Welcome Dinner', held at the Adelaide Parklands Terminal. The showcase of fabulous food and world-class wine, this pre-boarding event delivers the best bottles from around South Australia and sublime regional offerings from both land and sea.

FRIDAY, 18 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Onboard The Indian Pacific (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Overnight: Indian Pacific - Gold Class.

Today is all about the vast, unforgettable views of the Nullarbor Plain. You'll journey across this legendary expanse on the world's longest stretch of straight railway track, with endless horizons unfolding outside your window. Along the way, the train stops at Cook, once a bustling railway town, now a near-ghost outpost with stories etched into its weathered buildings. By evening, you will reach Rawlinna, on the edge of Australia's largest sheep station. Here, the outback comes alive as you dine beneath a canopy of stars at a spectacular signature long-table dinner, soaking up the atmosphere of this remarkable setting.

SATURDAY, 19 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Arrive Perth (Breakfast)

Wake to the soft light over Western Australia's Avon Valley, its rolling green hills a fitting finale to your Indian Pacific adventure. Savour a leisurely breakfast on board as the train makes its final approach into Perth. On arrival, you will disembark the train and continue with your own arrangements.

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9 DAY / 8 NIGHT ESCORTED TOUR ITINERARY

SATURDAY, 19 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Arrive Perth (Breakfast, Dinner)

Overnight: Duxton Hotel.

On arrival into Perth, you will transfer to your accommodation where you will spend the following 3 nights. The remainder of the day is at leisure. This evening you will enjoy dinner at the hotel restaurant.

SUNDAY, 20 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Margaret River, Chocolate, Nougat and Wine (Breakfast, Lunch)

Overnight: Duxton Hotel.

An early start this morning as you travel south from Perth, driving out into the farmland past grazing cattle, before stopping for morning tea (own expense) at the quirky and picturesque town of Cowaramup, famous for the 42 life-sized fibreglass Friesian cows that are located throughout. After exploring the town's cafes and chocolate shops, you will venture onward to Providore, where you can sample a range of delicious gourmet food products and wines. Driving into the heart of Margaret River, you will enjoy wine and nougat tastings at Bettenays Nougat Company, a highlight of this Margaret River wine tour, before your included lunch at one of Margaret River's famous wineries or breweries. Next, it's on to Vasse Virgin, where you can sample a huge selection of soaps, oils and other products. Continuing your trip out to the coast, you will take in the spectacular seascape views across the Indian Ocean from Canal Rocks, following the walkways out over these chiselled granite blocks to see the rushing ocean beneath. You will then start your return journey, which includes a stop at Busselton, where you will have a chance to view the iconic Busselton Jetty, the longest wooden jetty in the Southern Hemisphere, before continuing on back to Perth, arriving late this evening.

MONDAY, 21 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Pinnacles Desert and New Norcia (Breakfast, Lunch)

Overnight: Duxton Hotel.

Today's tour takes you inland to New Norcia, home to Australia's only Benedictine Abbey, a little piece of Spain full of history, art and architecture. On arrival you will hear the local history before viewing the chapel and museum artefacts gifted to the monastery by Popes and Royalty of Spain. Visit the famous Benedictine Community with a guided tour of the town and main sites including the museum and art gallery where you will find extraordinary artefacts dating back to when New Norcia was an Aboriginal mission. You will then visit the Abbey Church, home to one of only two large Moser organs, originally crafted in Germany. This is followed by a visit to St Gertrude's College, a grand gothic style building which was originally built as a girl's boarding school and opened in 1908. You will then stop at the produce shop selling olive oil, fruit, wine, New Norcia nut cake and breads, before enjoying a delicious lunch. This afternoon your tour continues to the mystical Pinnacles Desert for an easy paced walk where you will see the Pinnacles from the lookout over the park. There may even be time for a visit to the Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre. Return to Perth down the Indian Ocean drive, you may stop and see some of the unique wildflowers which only bloom in Western Australia.

TUESDAY, 22 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Depart Perth (Breakfast)

After breakfast you will check out of your hotel and transfer back to the airport for your departure flight.
