**MONDAY, 14 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Arrive Adelaide (Dinner)**

**Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.**

On arrival into Adelaide you will check into your hotel where you will spend the following 3 nights. This evening you will enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel where you will meet your fellow travellers.

**TUESDAY, 15 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Barossa and Hahndorf (Breakfast, Lunch)**

**Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.**

Today's tour takes you to the world-renowned Barossa, an incredible landscape boasting more than 160 vineyards and some of Australia's finest red wines. To start the tour, you will visit a selection of wineries, touring their vineyards and enjoying structured wine tastings. Your tour continues through the quaint villages of Bethany, Tanunda, Lyndoch and Nuriootpa, including a stop at Mengler Hill Lookout for a picturesque view of the valley before stopping for a platter lunch. This afternoon you will continue through the picturesque Adelaide Hills to Hahndorf, Australia's oldest German settlement. Here you will have free time to wander the main street filled with art and craft shops, German pubs, cafes and bakeries all selling locally produced food. Your afternoon concludes with a scenic drive to Mount Lofty Summit, Adelaide's highest peak. Take in the spectacular views of the city and the coastline - a perfect photo opportunity before returning to your hotel late this afternoon.

**WEDNESDAY, 16 SEPTEMBER 2026 - McLaren Vale Food and Wine (Breakfast, Lunch)**

**Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.**

Leaving your hotel this morning, today's tour starts with a scenic drive through some of Adelaide's southern metropolitan beaches, including Port Noarlunga and Moana before heading into the wine making region of McLaren Vale, best known for producing outstanding Shiraz. Stop for morning tea (extra cost), and learn a bit about the region, before heading off to your first cellar door. Over the course of the day, visit a selection of wineries to take part in vineyard tours and structured tastings. You will enjoy a delicious lunch at one of the wineries before some free time to explore the main street of McLaren Vale. You will then return to your hotel early this evening.

**THURSDAY, 17 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Depart Adelaide on The Indian Pacific (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Overnight: Indian Pacific - Gold Class.**

After checking out of your hotel this morning, you will have free time to explore the city on your own. This afternoon you will transfer to the Adelaide train station to board the Indian Pacific for your two night journey to Perth. This evening you will celebrate the start of your journey with the 'Flavours of South Australia Welcome Dinner', held at the Adelaide Parklands Terminal. The showcase of fabulous food and world-class wine, this pre-boarding event delivers the best bottles from around South Australia and sublime regional offerings from both land and sea.

**FRIDAY, 18 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Onboard The Indian Pacific (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

**Overnight: Indian Pacific - Gold Class.**

Today is all about the vast, unforgettable views of the Nullarbor Plain. You'll journey across this legendary expanse on the world's longest stretch of straight railway track, with endless horizons unfolding outside your window. Along the way, the train stops at Cook, once a bustling railway town, now a near-ghost outpost with stories etched into its weathered buildings. By evening, you will reach Rawlinna, on the edge of Australia's largest sheep station. Here, the outback comes alive as you dine beneath a canopy of stars at a spectacular signature long-table dinner, soaking up the atmosphere of this remarkable setting.

**SATURDAY, 19 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Arrive Perth (Breakfast)**

**Overnight: Duxton Hotel.**

Wake to the soft light over Western Australia's Avon Valley, it's rolling green hills a fitting finale to your Indian Pacific adventure. Savour a leisurely breakfast on board as the train makes its final approach into Perth. On arrival, you will be taken on an orientation tour of the city concluding at one of the world's largest and most beautiful city parks, Kings Park. Home to the Western Australia Botanic Garden, which displays over 3000 species of the State's unique flora - a sight unlike anywhere else in the world. Kings Park also offers spectacular views of the Swan River and back over the city skyline. Following the tour, you will transfer to your hotel where you will spend the next three nights.

**SUNDAY, 20 SEPTEMBER 2026 - Pinnacles Desert and New Norcia (Breakfast, Lunch)**

**Overnight: Duxton Hotel.**

Today's tour takes you inland to New Norcia, home to Australia's only Benedictine Abbey, a little piece of Spain full of history, art and architecture. On arrival you will hear the local history before viewing the chapel and museum artefacts gifted to the monastery by Popes and Royalty of Spain. Visit the famous Benedictine Community with a guided tour of the town and main sites including the museum and art gallery where you will find extraordinary artefacts dating back to when New Norcia was an Aboriginal mission. You will then visit the Abbey Church, home to one of only two large Moser organs, originally crafted in Germany. This is followed by a visit to St Gertrude's College, a grand gothic style building which was originally built as a girl's boarding school and opened in 1908. You will then stop at the produce shop selling olive oil, fruit, wine, New Norcia nut cake and breads, before enjoying a delicious lunch. This afternoon your tour continues to the mystical Pinnacles Desert for an easy paced walk where you will see the Pinnacles from the lookout over the park. There may even be time for a visit to the Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre. Return to Perth down the Indian Ocean drive, you may stop and see some of the unique wildflowers which only bloom in Western Australia.

You will then return to your hotel after lunch, with the rest of the day at leisure. This evening you will enjoy a farewell dinner with your group at the hotel restaurant.
